The South Australian Government is committed to health industries. We are overseeing the final phase of construction of the \$3.6 billion Adelaide BioMed City – one of the largest life sciences clusters in the southern hemisphere, while bringing together education, research, clinical care, start-up incubation and business development.

South Australian Health and Medical Research Institute (SAHMRI)

Brings together hundreds of researchers who are divided into seven broad themes, including cancer, mind and brain, and cardiovascular. SAHMRI provides nine fully flexible wet and dry laboratories to PC2 standards.

Housing 500 researchers over 12 levels, it will be the site of Australia's first proton therapy unit.

Royal Adelaide Hospital

Opening in a few months, the hospital will have 800 beds, with all overnight bedrooms being single rooms with private en-suites.
